What is it ?

A programme of 5 two hour modules for those students on the C/D borderline at GCSE to equip them to become more self confident, motivated independent learners. The structure of delivery is very flexible and can be tailored to suit the timetable needs of individual schools.

What does it cover ?

The 5 modules are each designed to cover a separate aspect of the process of creating motivated, successful students. These 5 aspects are :

- Promoting self awareness, self esteem and motivation
- Supporting raised aspirations through effective goal setting
- Personal organisation
- Specific Learn to Learn skills
- Generic thinking skills

How would the sessions be presented ?

The style is very much focussed on applying the latest knowledge of brain friendly learning techniques, using humour, visuals, practical application and linking the learning to real life situations. The documentation will include a clear structure for the formation of a study skills improvement policy and curriculum to ensure that the learning becomes embedded in the school in a sustainable way.

Will it work ?

The programme is run by someone who has had decades of experience of school improvement and innovative ways to support schools. As a Headteacher he was headhunted to, successfully, remove a school from Special Measures. He was also Director of the DfES Virtual Education Action Zone and Senior Advisor for a large Local Authority. All of that record of success and innovation has been brought to bear in this effective programme.
